filmarchives online provides easy and free access to catalogue information of film archives from all over Europe. Via the multi-lingual web portal film works can be searched for by content, filmographic data and physical characteristics. Search results provide information about existence and location of the materials as well as contact details to facilitate the access. The focus of the database is on **non-fiction material**; i.e. documentary and educational films, newsreels, travelogue, advertising, scientific, industrial, experimental, sports films, as well as animation films. **filmarchives online** is the result of the MIDAS project (Moving Image Database for Access and Re-use of European Film Collections). MIDAS had been initiated as a pilot project in the MEDIA Plus programme of the European Commission. It ran from January 2006 until January 2009 and was carried out by 18 institutions and archives under the lead of the Deutsches Filminstitut – DIF.

- Build a „digital showcase“ for collections in European film archives and cinémathèques
 - Films and film clips, trailers etc. (esp. non-fiction)
 - Images: posters, photos, stills and set photographs, designs and drawings etc.
 - Text material: reviews, correspondence, censorship and rating visa etc.
- Central access point to federated digital collections and repositories
- „Registry“ of digital objects and film-related authority data (Film works, Persons)

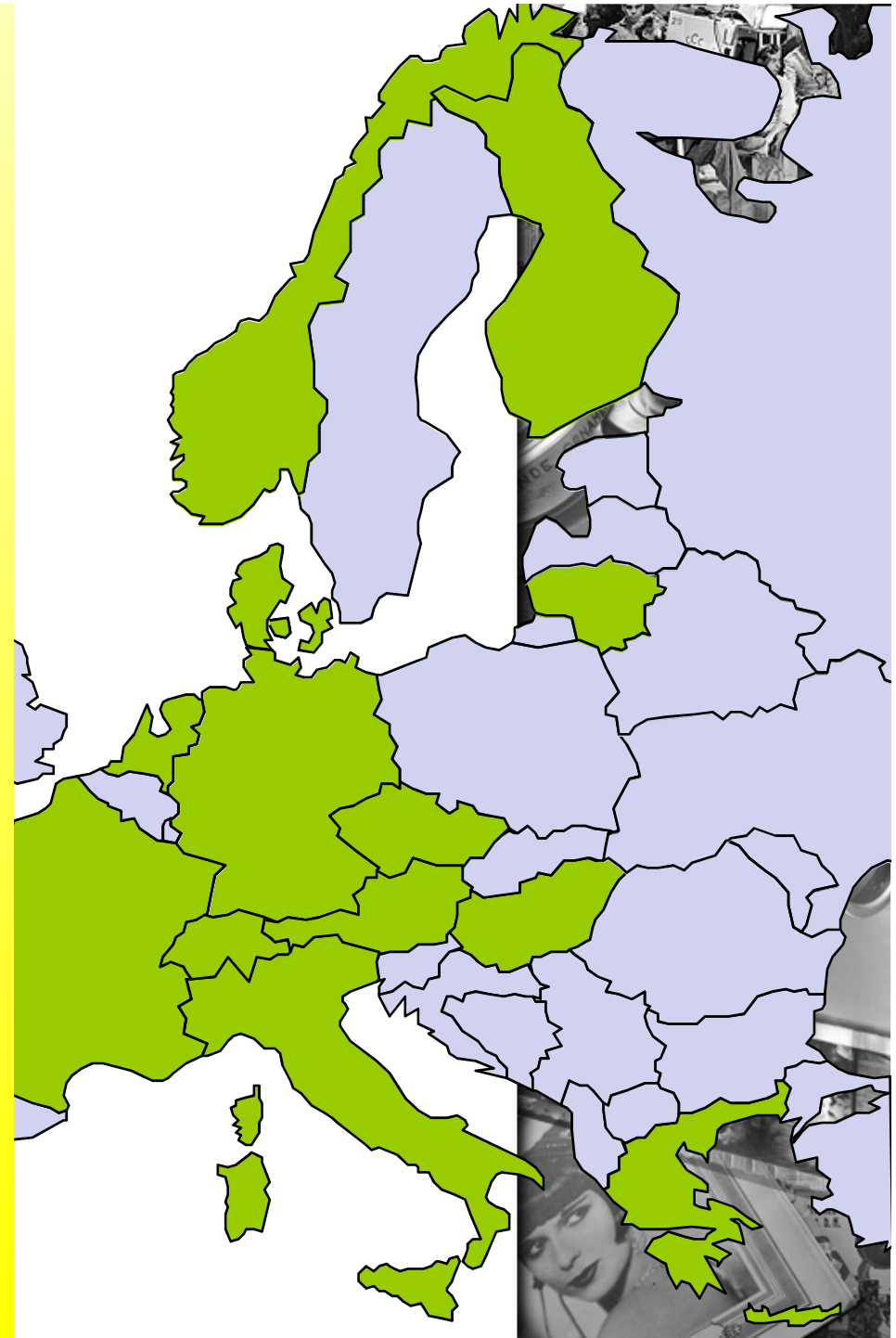

Friedrich Christian Anton Lang, geboren am 5. Dezember 1890 in Wien, Sohn des Architekten und Stadtbaumeisters (Bauunternehmers) Anton Lang und seiner Frau Paula, geb. Schlesinger. 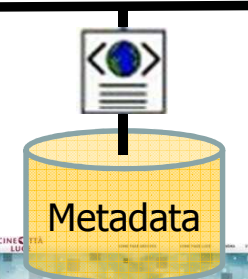
Infrastructure setup



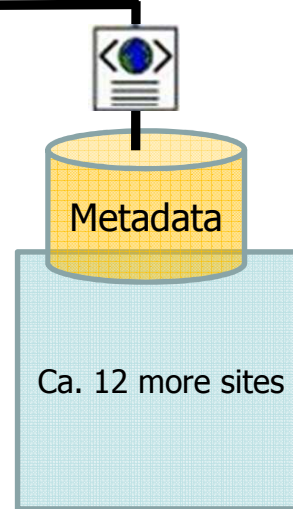

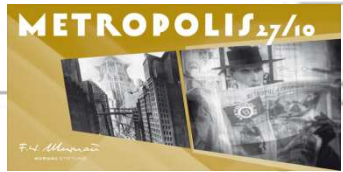


Interoperability: Challenges & Tools

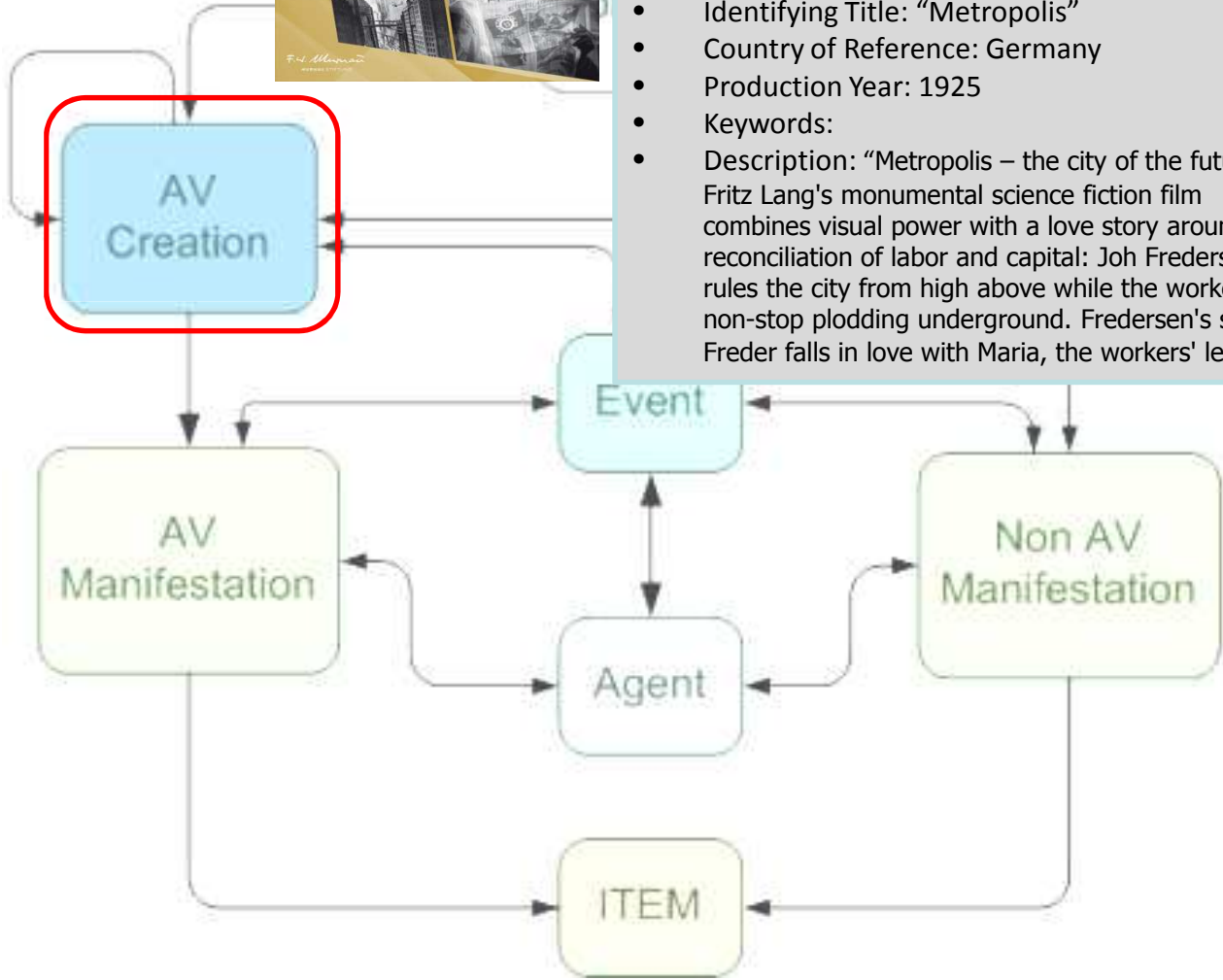
- Information about the same films and persons coming from different sources

- Match & Merge tool for finding and merging records describing identical film works or persons: „Authority File Manager“ (AFM)



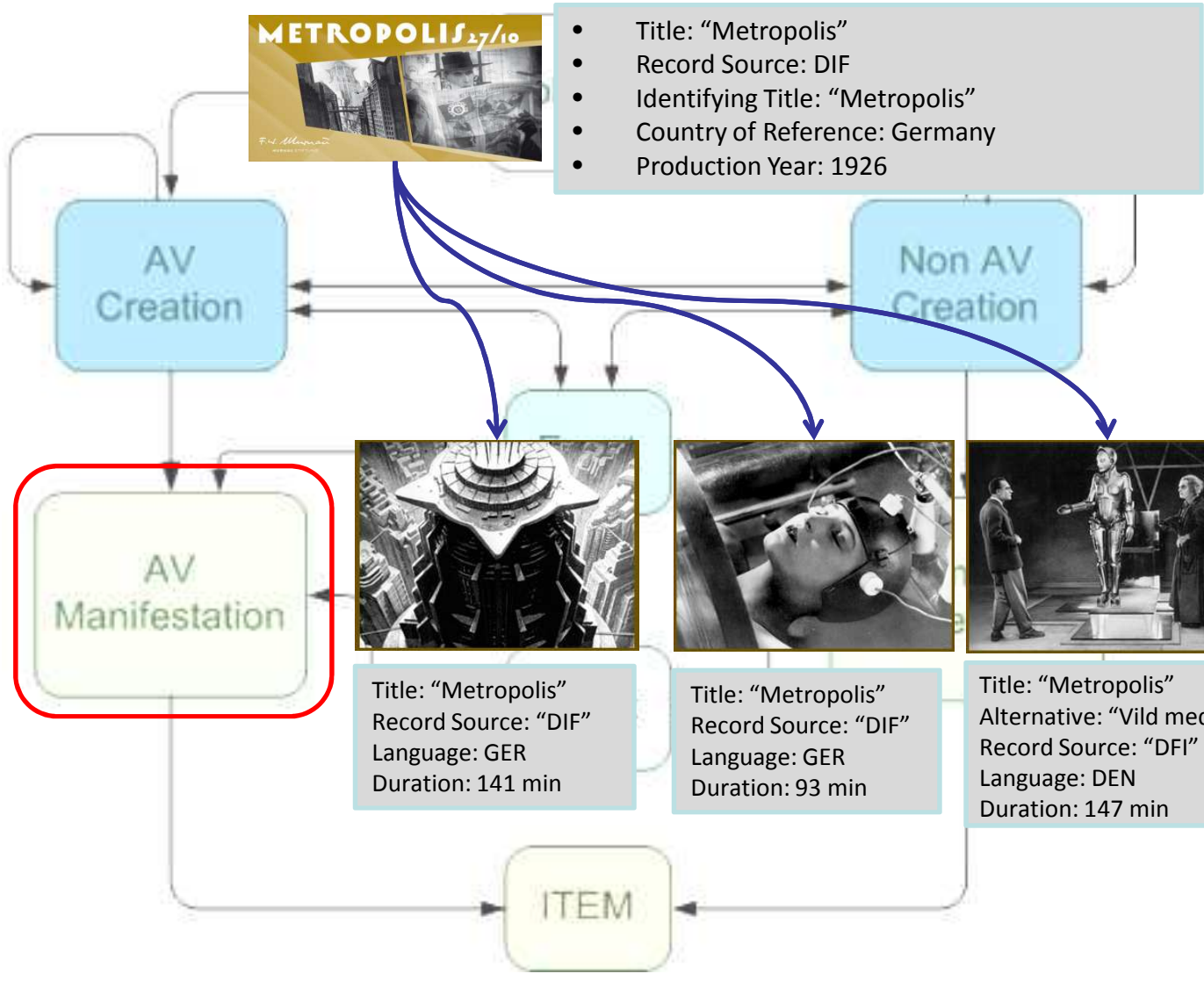
An example of the use of the EFG Metadata Schema

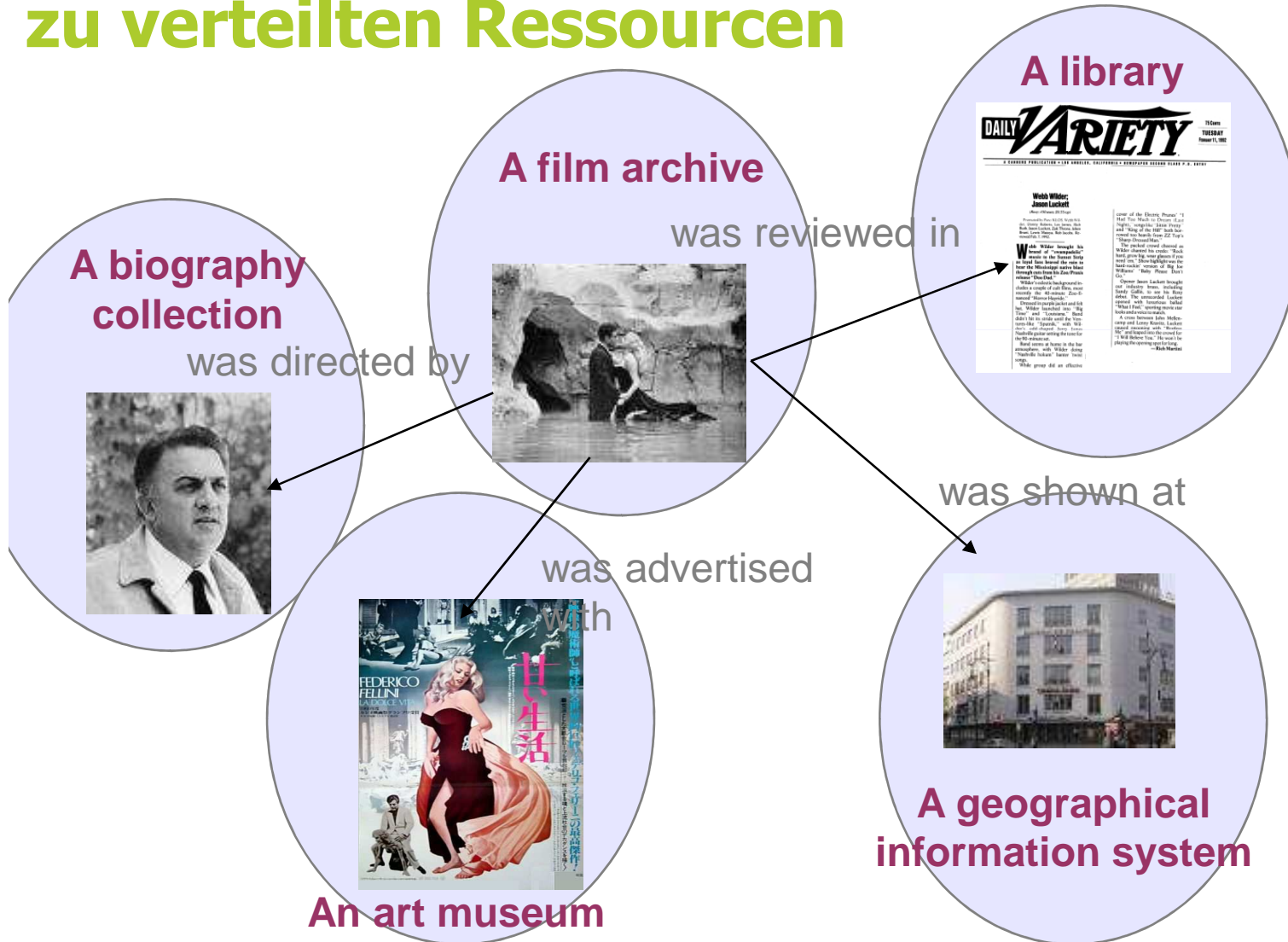

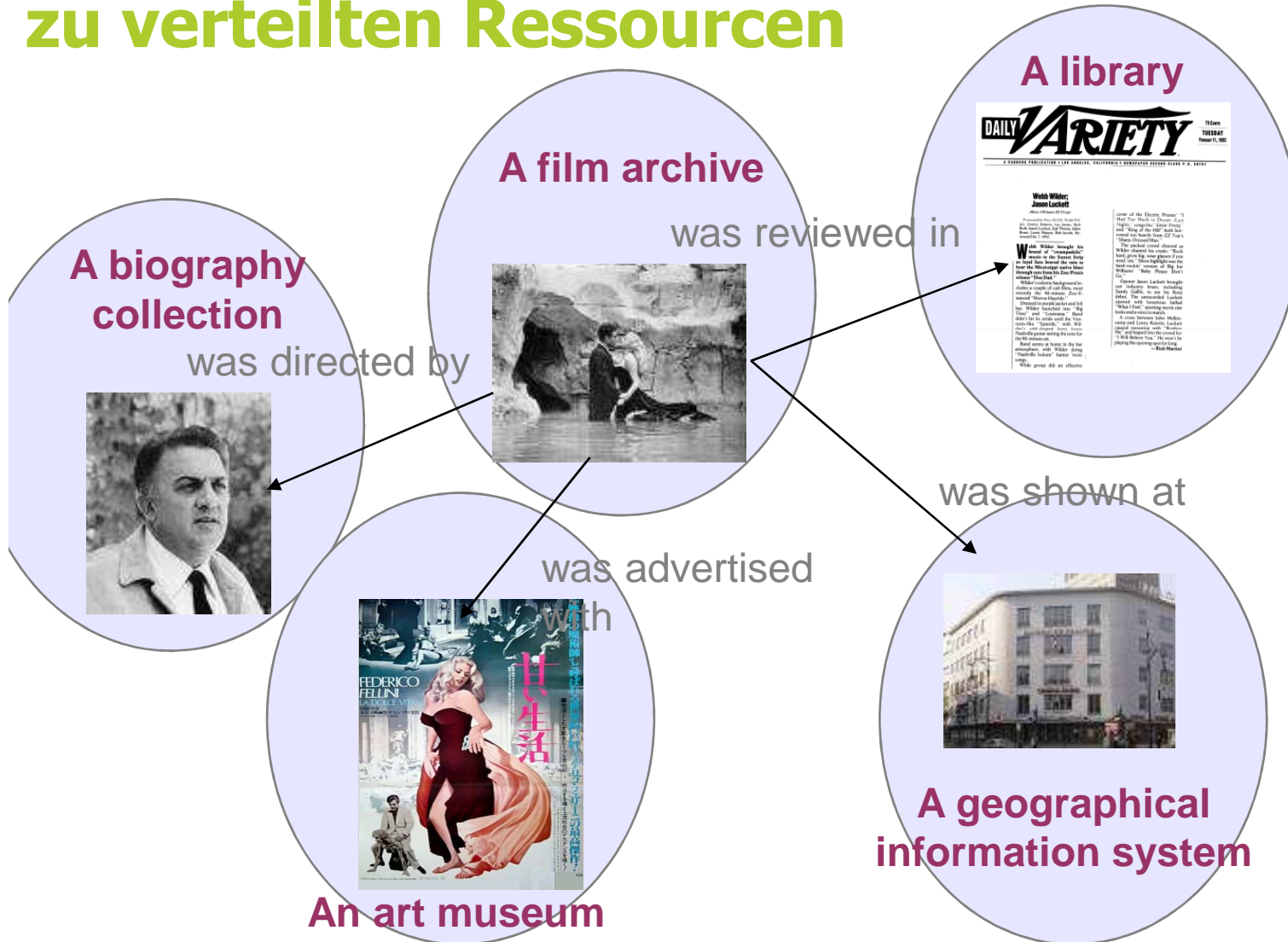
- e.g. Television archives vs Film archives

- „Data Provider Agreements“
 - Europeana-DPA vs. EFG-DPA
 - Europeana-DPA vs. EDM & Linked Data
 - Changes in concepts → Changes in contracts
 - Insecurity for archives, projects, Europeana
- Clear metadata licensing requirements already before start of interoperability projects needed!
